Wanted to drop you a line about our 22ft. Beat. I've used it for all one season new in all kinds of weather; dead calm to 40 mph winds, hot to Coldino snow). I've operated beats for over 40 years and this is the best rough water beat, for it's size, I've over worked with. We've used it for huey maintenance, dock maint., shereline clean up, beat operator training, and in our dive program. The divers tell me that getting in and out of the water is very easy with the dive platforms, even with tank and weight beit on.

The deck space and the gunnel height make working on buoys a snap. We transport buoy anchors that weigh about 1000 lbs. No problem!

Along with being easy to work out of, the clean lines make maintenance and clean up simple.

The only thing i've added is a good time radio-for me, also a sea water system to clean buoys and the beat. Buoys get protty pasty when pulled out of the water.

Thanks for the workmanship. You'll can be proud
